

FAMILY ASSISTANCE

Providing Stability for Families




The Family Assistance Program **provides instant relief for clients that are faced with a tragedy and need help immediately.** This program helps clients with rent, utilities, medical bills, education, and food. This will enable the client to stabilize their situation so that they can cover their own expenses and maintain selfsufficiency.

SELF-SUFFICIENCY PROGRAM

A Roadmap for Independence

FAITH recognizes the potential for development among its clients enrolled in programs like **Housing and Well-Being** and the **Employment and Career Development Program**. The overarching goal is to address the deficiency in employability skills, rectify existing shortcomings, and foster an environment conducive to understanding and influencing clients' ability and desire for positive change. Through strategic interventions, FAITH aims to empower its clients towards sustainable employment and improved socio-economic outcomes.





JANAZAH (BURIAL) PROGRAM

Religious Obligation

For many in our community, it has been challenging to observe the tradition of Janazah and burial due to economic hardship. **FAITH makes sure families who are are unable to manage financially are not left behind without a proper burial of a loved one.** The average discounted cost for FAITH is \$3,300 per burial.



EMERGENCY PROGRAM

This program **provides one-time assistance for the year.** Clients are assisted with rent, utility bills, medical bills, and more. Through this program, clients find instant relief for any crisis they are facing.



SHORT-TERM ASSISTANCE

Short-term assistance is **provided to clients for 3-6 months.** This assistance is provided to clients who are unable to be self-sufficient because of a temporary setback such as a medical issue.



LONG-TERM ASSISTANCE

Long-Term Assistance is **provided to clients who are unable to be self-sufficient for longer than 6 months.** Some long-term clients are unable to achieve self-sufficiency because of terminal illness, physical or mental disability or illness, mothers with young children, and the elderly.



CHILDREN'S ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

Serving Children in Need

Provides children with diverse opportunities for growth and learning. We **provide financial assistance for afterschool and weekend programs and distribute school supplies, new clothing and shoes.** The program also arranges special programs for Ramadan and Eid, and plans fun and safe events for children and their families to socialize, build confidence and learn.



Stronger & Happier Families (SHF) Program

SHF supports local families in understanding and effectively managing domestic conflicts and disputes related to family dynamics to disseminate constructive conflict resolution skills and strengthen family relationships.

Domestic Violence (DV) Program

FAITH's Two-Prong Approach to Domestic Violence Prevention consists of 1) providing direct assistance to victims of domestic violence and 2) Community accountability- where FAITH actively involves the community like mosques and Imams to help protect the victims of domestic violence and to hold the perpetrators accountable. FAITH is educating the Muslim community on the effects of domestic violence on the family and the community with seminars for Imams, seminars for men, and seminars for women as well as providing information and resources.

FAMILY EMPOWERMENT

Keeping Families Safe

Family Empowerment at FAITH means developing and preserving families as individuals and cohesive family members. To that end, **we empower families through assistance in mediation and counseling.** This department also has trained staff that manages a domestic violence program that addresses victims of physical, verbal, mental and spiritual abuse.



SCHOLARSHIPS

Solid Foundations

FAITH's mission is to empower members of the community and we strongly believe that **investing in education is a key aspect in creating a solid foundation for self-sufficiency and success in life.** Pursuing an education has its challenges, one of foremost being the costs associated with higher education. In the interest of alleviating such obstacles, FAITH will now offer scholarships to eligible students based on financial need.

Through the donations of generous families in the community, FAITH is currently offering **high school scholarships and a college scholarship.**



FOOD PROGRAMS

Food for Thought

Low-income residents struggle to feed their families sufficient and nutritious food. Households under economic stress experience a higher likelihood of periodic food insecurity and have to make choices on how to budget their limited resources.

FAITH, dedicated to supporting vulnerable community members, implements various initiatives such as the *Qurbani Program*, *Herndon Without Hunger*, and the *Food Pantry*.



THRIFT STORE

A Helping (Second) Hand

The FAITH Thrift Store in Herndon, VA, is a **great resource for individuals in need who are looking for affordable clothing, furniture, and household items.** With a wide selection of high-quality secondhand goods, the store provides a cost-effective shopping experience that supports a good cause.

All proceeds from sales go directly towards supporting FAITH's programs and services, ensuring that those in need have access to essential resources. In addition, the store is staffed by friendly, knowledgeable volunteers passionate about helping the community.
